Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Form

WUE is the Western Undergraduate Exchange, a program of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). Through WUE, students in western states may enroll in many two-year and four-year college programs at a reduced tuition level: 150 percent of the institution's regular resident tuition. WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Legal resident of participating state: Alaska, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, or Wyoming.
- Tuition for WUE students is 150 percent of institution's in-state resident tuition.
- Acceptance to Eastern Arizona College.
- Full-time student status at Eastern Arizona College.
- Annual accumulation of 24 credit hours at a minimum 2.0 grade average.

STATE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

Complete WUE application and attach one (1) valid supporting document from your State of Residence that is current or within one year of application date.

- Drivers license
- Motor vehicle registration
- State income tax return for previous year
- High school transcript or diploma
- Property ownership document
- Dependency status indicated on parent's federal income tax return from previous year
- Bank statement addressed to your state of residency

Note: You cannot count a semester toward Arizona residency while on the WUE
