Online: Register over the Internet using Gila Hank Online, EAC's real-time registration system. Go to www.eac.edu and click the Gila Hank Online link. Walk-in: Records and Registration Office, Student Services Building, weekdays 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

If you did not receive your Monster ID, call (928) 428-8270. When logging in for the first time, use your Student ID as your password. You will be prompted to change your password. After your first visit, use your Monster ID and password for future login.
