College and Area Information:

Organizational Relationship:

The ADN Nursing Instructor - Gila Community College Program Globe reports to the Dean of the designated campus. Funding for this position is contingent upon continuation of the external contract between the Gila County Community College District and Graham County Community College District.

Required Qualifications:

- Master's Degree or higher in Nursing, Nursing Education or a closely related Allied Health Field, as well as a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing
- Minimum of three years experience as a professional nurse providing direct patient care
- Professional nursing license that is active and in good standing
- Current knowledge and skill in Medical-Surgical Nursing, Family Nursing, and Advanced Nursing including instruction and clinical supervision
- Teaching experience in Nursing
- Computer literacy

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience using computers for supplemental instruction
- Innovative teaching experience
- Full time community college teaching experience in Nursing

Responsibilities:

- Teach both classroom and clinical instruction in one or more of the following areas: Medical-Surgical Nursing, Family Nursing, and Advanced Nursing.
- Fulfill a minimum requirement of 32 adjusted load hours of instruction per academic year: up to six adjusted load hours of overload may be required.
- Maintain a minimum accountability week equivalent to 35 hours on campus for teaching, advising and assisting students, preparing labs and lectures, consulting with colleagues, and other related activities.
- Maintain laboratory equipment and purchase laboratory supplies.
- Participate in developing, implementing and evaluating the nursing program of learning.
- Participate in developing standards and assessment processes for the admission, academic progression, and graduation of students.
- Provide for the supervision of students in all clinical experiences.
- Be responsible for updating course outlines as well as pre- and post-tests and developing curriculum.
- Teach evening or weekend classes as necessary.
- Serve on institutional committees as necessary and perform other duties as assigned.
