OVERVIEW

Sidewalk Chalk Art Contest: Students can enter this category in addition to Color Mixing and Matching, Drawing-Still Life, Graphic Design-Logo, Poster Project, and Art Exhibition contests.

- Students may bring a design with them, chalk will be provided. Students will have from 8:30 am until 11:00 am to complete their design.

First, second, and third place medallions will be awarded in each category.

Points will be awarded on the following basis:

1. Originality
2. Color and design
3. Execution of the design
