CAD/DRAFTING CONTESTS

WHO: Open to all high school students

WHEN: Both contests run from 9-10:30 a.m.

WHERE: EAC Industrial Technical Education (ITE) Building, South Campus, Rooms 101 and 106.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Architectural CAD

Contestants will create a complete floor plan of an assigned project. The plan will include all walls, dimensions, cabinets, doors, windows, callouts, room sizes and names, appliances, and roof. You will also be required to complete elevations of this floor plan. The drawing will be placed on an A-size title block format and printed. Room 101

Mechanical CAD

Contestants will be required to complete an orthographic drawing of a 3-D solid model object. The drawing will be completed on an A-size title block format and printed. The object will have multiple views. Students must also be able to insert an isometric view of the object as well. Room 106

Contestants may select from the following software to complete their project

- AUTOCAD 2019
- Architectural 2019
- Inventor 2019
- Revit 2019
- Solid Works 2019

OVERVIEW

- Students may enter only one contest and each school can send up to five contestants per contest. (10 total)
