GENERAL GUIDELINES

Students will demonstrate laboratory techniques involving mass and volume in addition to applying what they have learned in chemistry to conduct short laboratory activities. Acid/Base Chemistry, Chemical Reactions, Density, Gas Laws, and Solution Chemistry are the topics of focus for this competition.
