SKILLS DAY FILM FESTIVAL 2019



WHO: Open to all high-school students.

WHAT: A Skills Day Film Festival 2019 for high school students to develop and submit films for prizes, certificates, and recognition.

WHEN: Films will be publicly viewed on Thursday, April 11, 2019 beginning at 9 a.m. Awards will be given directly after viewing. Winners will be announced at screening.

WHERE: EAC Lee Little Theatre on North Campus in Activities Center

WHY: To develop media skills and gain experience with film projects.

HOW: Fill out entry form and include URL link where we are able to download your files. i.e. Vimeo. Submit to : skillsdayfilmfestival@eac.edu

DEADLINE: Submission no later than Monday, March 18, 2019 by 11:59 p.m.

COST: There is no cost to enter.

RULES & TERMS

- All films must be G-rated. That means for a general audience.
- Films can be of any genre (i.e. narrative, documentary, experimental) and must not contain any adult content or language. Adult content includes violence, language, or other adult themes may cause film to be eliminated from consideration.
- No profanity
- No nudity
- No drug use depicted
- Film Duration: 1 minute to 10 minutes
- All films must contain title and credits
- You can submit more than one film entry.
- One film per submission
- Films to be submitted by one individual. Only the student PRIMARILY responsible for the film (usually the director, but not always) can submit. Teachers who oversee projects may not submit under their name. There is a place on the entry form to put credits for additional people who were instrumental in the creation of the film.
- We assume you have secured all creative rights in your film. This includes but not limited to music, actors, script, location, stock footage, and crew, etc. Music clearances are hard to come by and usually expensive. Therefore, you are better off composing your own music or have a friend do it for you.
- What about brands or logos? It's not a good idea to put brands or logos in your film. Sometimes it's unavoidable (a FedEx truck drove through the background of your shot), but if you can avoid it (wear different clothes, drink out of glass instead of a can, peel the label off of the bottle), you should.
- Students must complete entry form including the URL link via Vimeo to skillsdayfilmfestival@eac.edu
- Films may also be submitted on a DVD along with a copy of your paperwork to:

JUDGING

- Finalists will be notified by email and will be invited to attend the screening at Skills Day.
- All winners' invitations will be sent one week prior to event.
- Prizes are distributed through the following categories: directing, editing, cinematography, acting, and audience choice.

HOW MUCH HELP CAN I GET FROM OTHERS?

You the student have to be PRIMARILY responsible for the film. Others can offer suggestions, but they can't do things for you. Others can move a light for you or cook lunch for the crew, but they can't tell you how to frame the shot or write any of the script.

WHY A VIMEO LINK? CAN'T I JUST SEND YOU A LINK TO MY YOUTUBE CHANNEL?

Vimeo is a password protected site that filmmakers use to secure their films online. Because most of the filmmakers and some of the talent are underage, we do not recommend uploading films for online use without a password protection. It also makes sure people can't steal your work and reuse it.

If you can't upload your film, you can also mail a file on a writable disk to Glen Cashetta.
