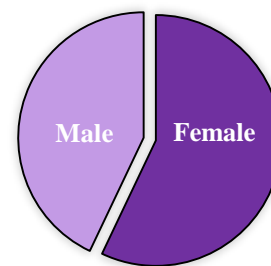

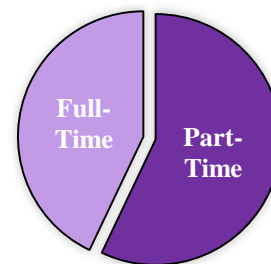

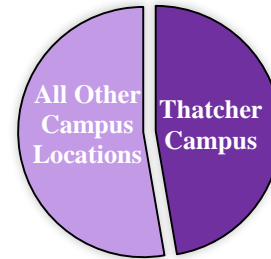


Full-Time Versus Part-Time Students	Enrollment	Percentage

Full-Time.....	1304	42.9%



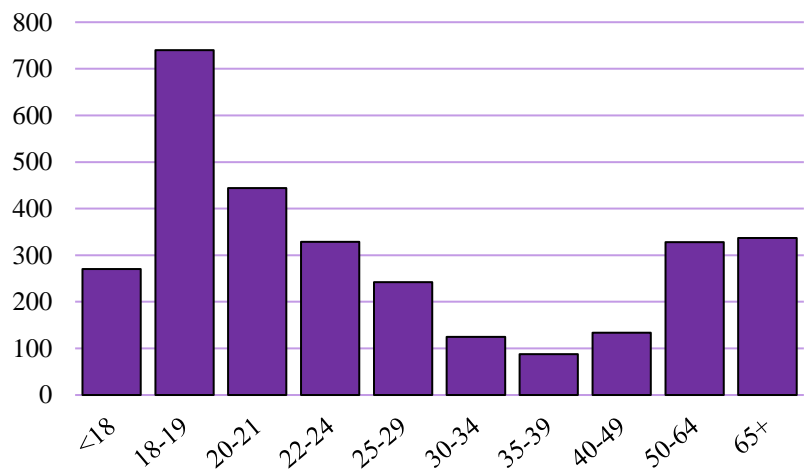
Campus Location

All Other Campus Locations.....	3386	52.7%



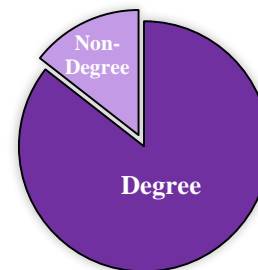
