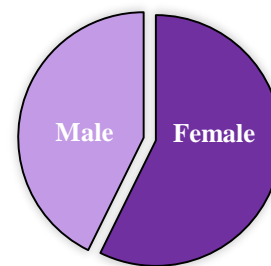

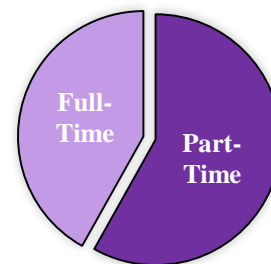

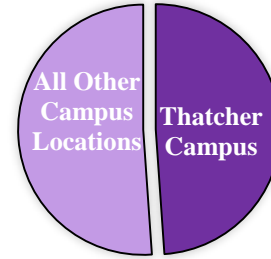


Full-Time Versus Part-Time Students	Enrollment	Percentage

Full-Time.....	1303	41.9%



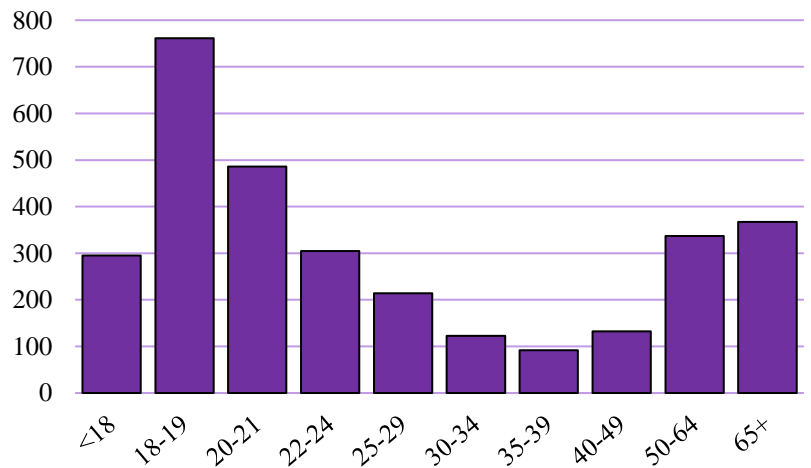
Campus Location

All Other Campus Locations.....	3253	51.1%



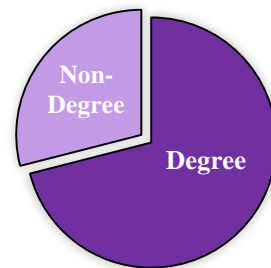
