

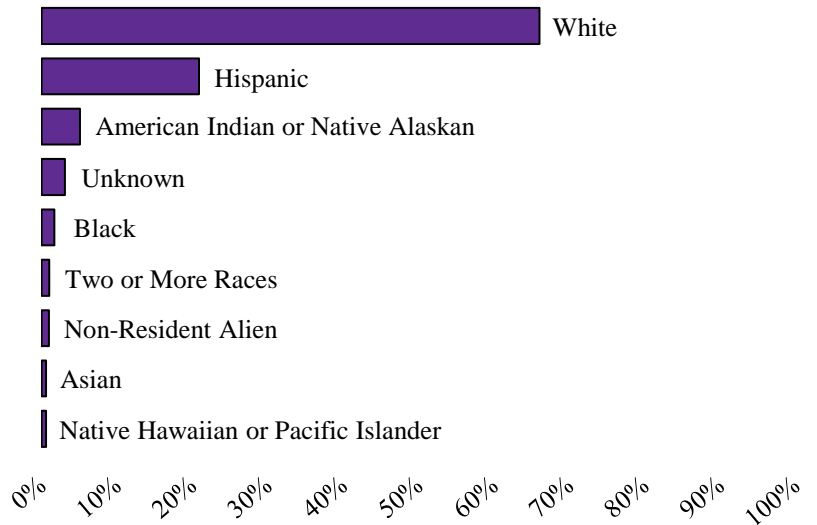

Thatcher Campus Student Profile Fall 2019

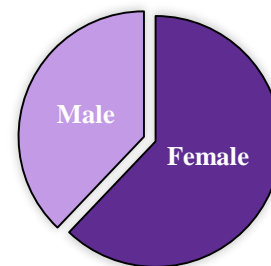

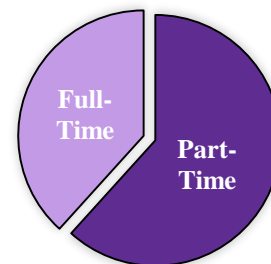

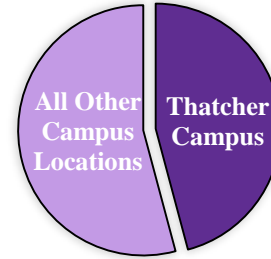


Full-Time Versus Part-Time Students	Enrollment	Percentage

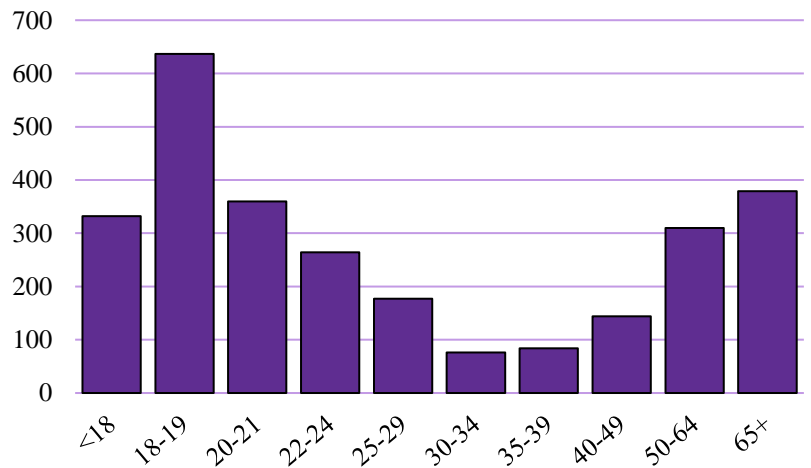
Campus Location

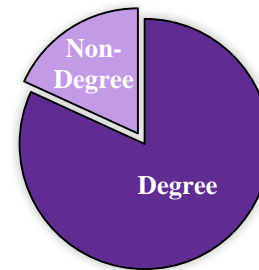
