

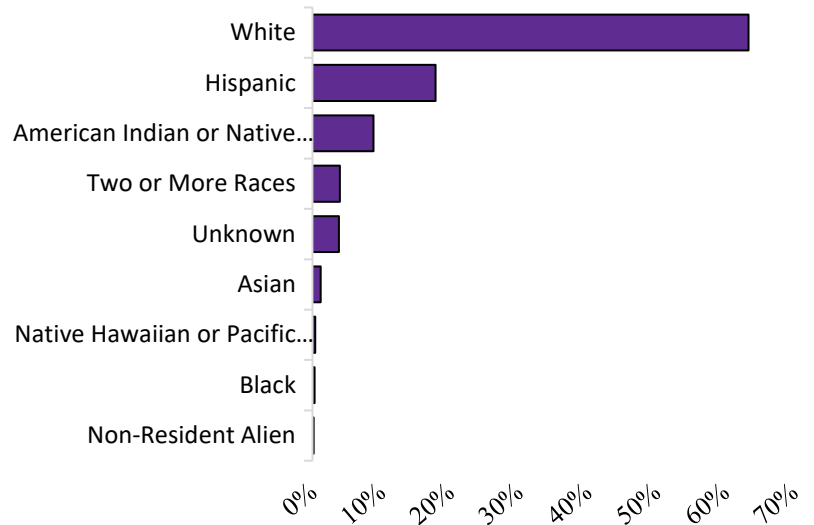

**Gila Community College Provisional District Student Profile Fall 2020**

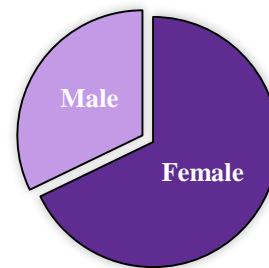

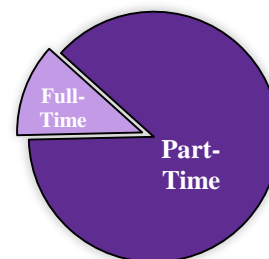

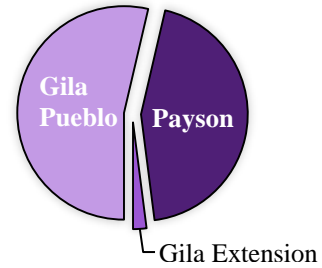


Full-Time Versus Part-Time Students	Enrollment	Percentage

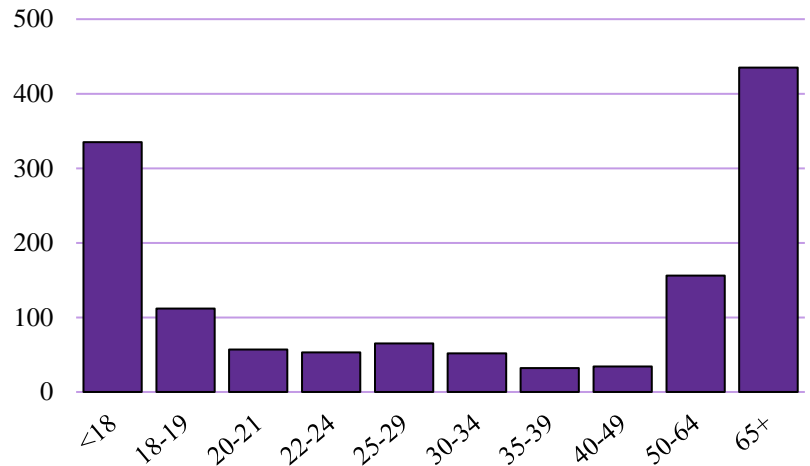

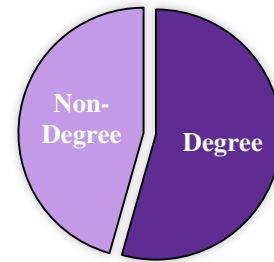
